STONEGRABER SCHOLARSHIP FUND

SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION:	Established in memory of Eleanor C. and David P. Stonegraber. Mrs. Stonegraber was an occupational therapist in the Buffalo and Rochester areas and director of occupational therapy at the Rochester Psychiatric Center at the time of her retirement in 1959.
SELECTION CRITERIA:	<p>The Stonegraber Scholarship provides partial funding for occupational therapy and physical therapy students entering their last year of study. To qualify for this scholarship, an applicant must not have previously received a Stonegraber Award and must:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Have on file in the Office of Financial Aid a current Financial Aid Form (FAFSA, http://www.fafsa.ed.gov) at the time of application, AND2. OT and PT students entering their last year of study
WHO CAN APPLY:	Occupational and physical therapy students at UB.
AMOUNT AWARDED:	Amounts typically range from \$500 to \$2,000
INFORMATION FOR APPLYING:	<p>Students interested in the Stonegraber Scholarship should file a financial statement with the Financial Aid Office during the fall semester.</p> <p>Will need to provide supplemental material with the application:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. <u>Academic/Professional Motivation, Goals & Accomplishments:</u> 4 or fewer double-spaced, typewritten pages, on which you provide a brief biographical sketch describing how you became interested in OT or PT, your professional goals, and any related accomplishments. You may also wish to describe pertinent extracurricular activities, hobbies, or any paid or volunteer work experiences that you have had.2. <u>Financial Need:</u> Attach a typewritten page or two that describes your recent loan history, current indebtedness, and/or personal financial circumstances including eligibility or lack of eligibility for other forms of financial assistance. Awards to Stonegraber Scholars are unrestricted; that is, funds can be used for any purpose deemed appropriate by the recipient. You may, however, wish to describe your intentions for use of funding, should you be selected. <p>APPLICATION CAN BE DOWNLOADED ON THE SCHOOL OF PUBLIC HEALTH WEBSITE.</p> <p><i>Students apply for/receive the scholarship in their final year of study.</i></p>
