- POSITION:** Two positions available in Environmental Epidemiology in the Department of Social and Preventive Medicine.
- RANK:** Assistant/Associate/Full Professor (tenure-track, state supported)
- QUALIFICATIONS:** Doctoral level training (Ph.D., M.D. or equivalent) in epidemiology or a related field with a research focus on the role of environmental factors in disease etiology and prevention. Candidates at the associate or full professor rank will be expected to have a solid and current record of extramurally funded research and peer-reviewed publications. Candidates at the assistant professor rank will be evaluated based on their research productivity and potential.
- We seek applications from highly qualified and motivated individuals who would like to share in the development of an expanding environmental epidemiology program committed to excellence in research and scholarship.
- RESPONSIBILITIES:** The successful candidate will develop an extramurally funded, independent research program, teach courses, mentor graduate students, collaborate with other university researchers and engage in appropriate service activities.
- PROFESSIONAL ENVIRONMENT** The Department of Social and Preventive Medicine has a long and productive history of research and teaching in chronic disease epidemiology and prevention including research on environmental exposures in relation to disease. As part of the newly formed School of Public Health and Health Professions (SPHHP), the department is in a phase of expansion that will lead to more than doubling of the size of the faculty in the next several years.
- The University at Buffalo is a major research-intensive institution, the largest and most comprehensive of the campuses of the State University of New York. The SPHHP and the other schools of the Academic Health Center (Schools of Medicine and Biomedical Sciences, Dental Medicine, Pharmacy and Pharmaceutical Sciences, and Nursing), Roswell Park Cancer Institute, The New York Center of Excellence in Bioinformatics and Life Sciences, and the Buffalo National Center for Geographic Information Analysis provide a rich environment for collaborative research.
